# Who's in your circle?

1. Who is important to you?
2. Who do you talk to every day?

# Grammar focus: Subject VS. object pronouns

<b>Subject pronouns</b>	I	You	He	She	It	We	They
<b>Object pronouns</b>	me	you	him	her	it	us	them

## Explanation:

1. Subject pronouns do the action: *“She helps her brother.”*
2. Object pronouns receive the action: *“Her brother helps her.”*

17. Nephew — The son of your brother or sister.
18. Niece — The daughter of your brother or sister.
19. Stepfather — Your mother's new husband (not your real father).
20. Stepmother — Your father's new wife (not your real mother).

21. Stepbrother — The son of your stepmother or stepfather.
