Travel and daily routines on holiday


Understand the difference between past simple and present simple and use both tenses to talk about travel experiences and routines.

Grammar focus box

Present simple	Past simple
Used for habits, routines, or facts.	Used for finished actions in the past.
<i>“I travel every summer.”</i>	<i>“I travelled to Spain last summer.”</i>
<i>“She stays in hotels near the beach.”</i>	<i>“She stayed in a hotel near the beach last year.”</i>



Tip: Time words like “every day”, “usually”, “last week”, “yesterday” help show which tense is used.

This year, she is staying in her own country. She visits local museums and tries new restaurants in her city.

Last year, Anna went to Italy. She stayed in a small hotel in Rome. She visited the Colosseum, ate pizza every day, and took lots of photos. It was a great trip!

She says, "I love travelling! Sometimes I go far, and sometimes I stay close. But I always enjoy my time!"
